The 26<sup>th</sup> European Research Vessel Operators (ERVO) meeting will be hosted by the Marine Technology Unit –(UTM-CSIC), in Vigo from the 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

ERVO meetings address common issues/questions that affect research vessel operators for the purpose of identifying solutions for improving services to the scientific community and developing best practice in the operation of Research Vessels. Members present their National Reports on activities, including any future plans for acquisitions/upgrades.

Presentations on new vessel builds are invited and a number of special topics is discussed at each meeting.

The ERVO Meetings provide an opportunity for RV Managers to exchange information on their national fleets, highlighting trends in the requirements for sea-going vessels and new technological developments for RV operations.


