## Background

- 8<sup>th</sup> INMARTECH meeting, earlier meetings have been in Southampton (UK), SCRIPPS, San Diego, (USA); NIOZ, Texel (the Netherlands); JAMSTEC, Yokosuka (Japan); BAS, Cambridge (UK); WHOI, Woodshole (USA); and by Ifremer, Toulouse, (France).
- initiated, and coordinated, by the annual International Research Ship Operators meetings (IRSO, formerly ISOM).
- Purpose of INMARTECH: to provide a forum for (operational) marine technicians to meet.
- The aims: exchange of knowledge and experiences, to improve equipment performance, deployment and operational techniques during scientific cruises on research vessels.
