2. Activities

Joined seismic campaign with RV Simon Stevin

- Testing of different high-resolution seismic source and receiver combinations at different offset configurations
- Development of an efficient prospection methodology for submerged landscapes and cultural heritage at sea
- Positive interaction between two different crews/

Miscellaneous:

- RV Belgica became an ocean station with the ESFRI ICOS-ERIC (Integrated Carbon Observation System)
- RV Belgica's EM3002 multibeam (FPS Economy) obtained IHO "special order" (highest category < 40 m water depth)

Flooding Incident:

- 19.07, the ship flooded in the harbor; up to 1,2 m sea water in ER
- all cabling and affected systems needed to be replaced or completely overhauled
- In total 59 days of planned science days were lost and 17 research projects were affected

3. Refit & Replacement process



- The budget of ca. **1 M€ incl. VAT** for the obsolescence maintenance has been foreseen
- Will foresee in a new platform management system (alarm systems, propulsion management, etc.)
- Will foresee in a new electrical steering of the hydraulic systems
- Is planned in 2016 for a period of ca. 5 months (DAMEN, Dunkerque)

- Working group with Cabinet Science Policy was initiated
- Support letters of all major institutes and universities are foreseen
- Support letters of new private partners are foreseen
- Working groups with Defence for the technical part of the tender, the purchase and the exploitation is foreseen in 2016
