explore and develop opportunities for collaboration, sharing and/or exchanging ship time, personnel, instruments and equipment;

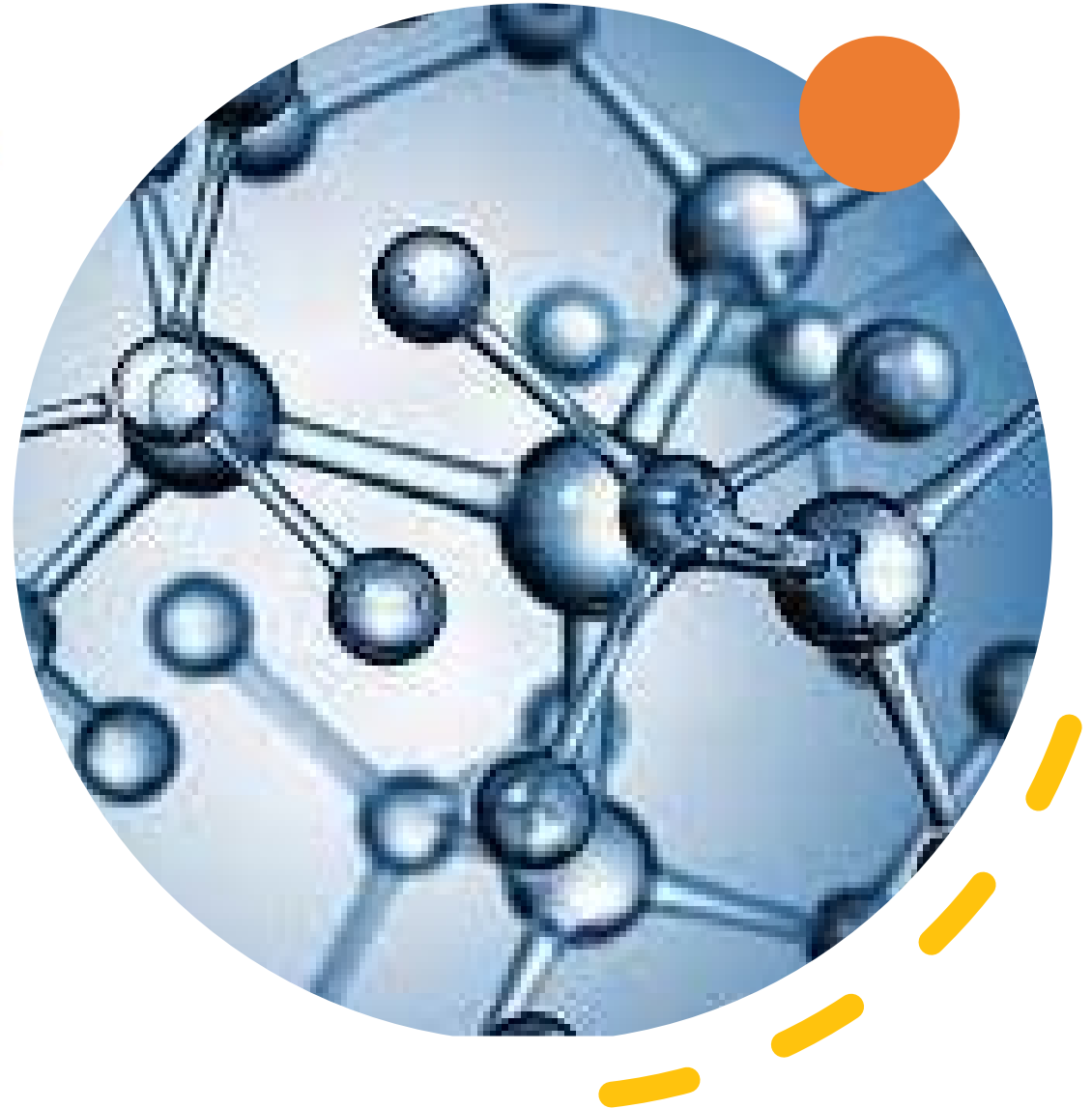
benchmark their research ship and associated equipment operations with other comparable operators; and

- All regionally based interested and relevant parties welcome.



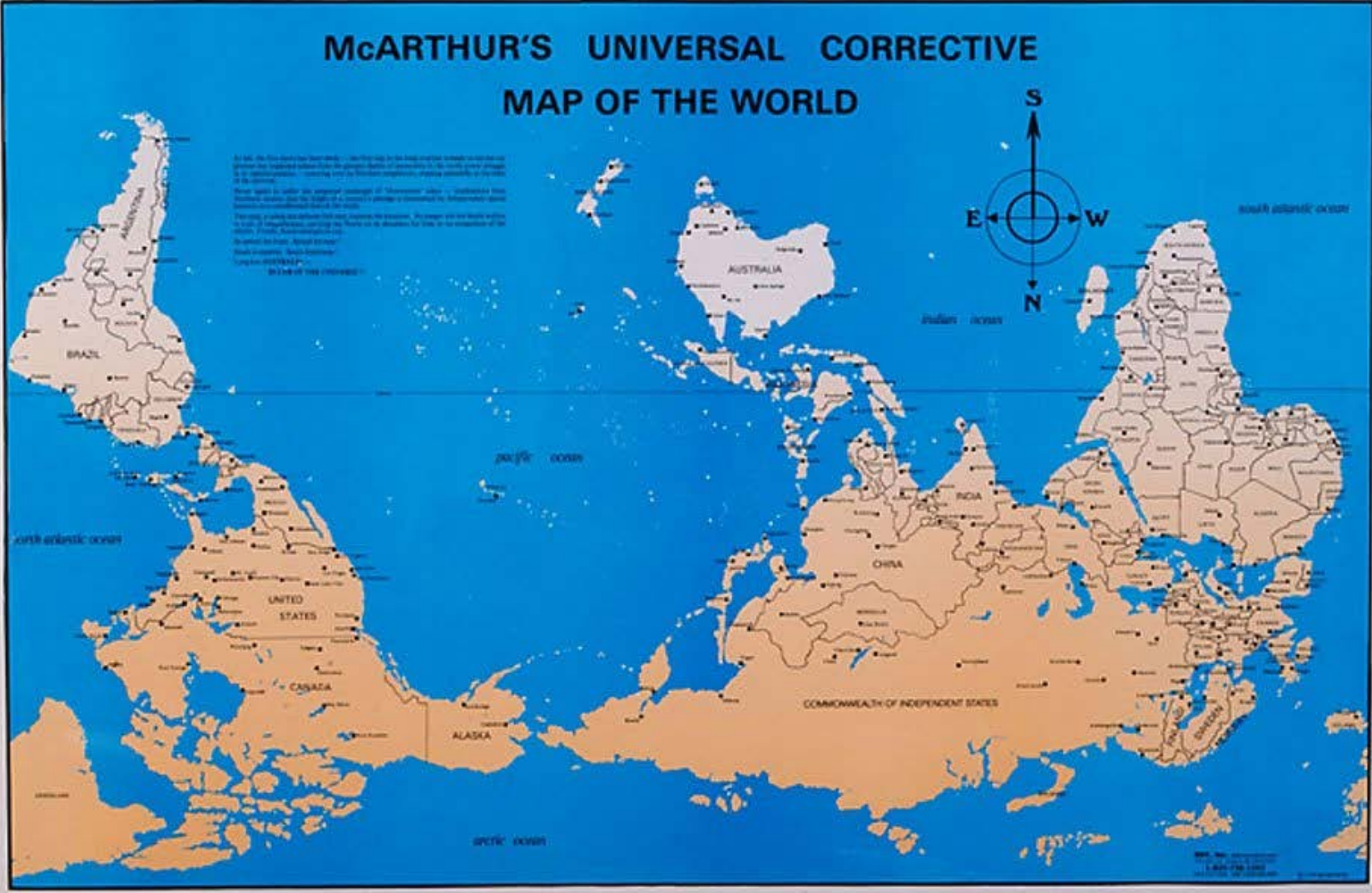
