OFEG members: Ifremer (France), BMBF (Germany), NIOZ (Netherlands), IMR-UoB (Norway), CSIC (Spain), NERC (UK).

NSF, MI are connected to OFEG via NERC

Main objective: exchange of ship time and major equipment based on 'bartering' > without money-exchange; or joint cruises

Exchange rate based on value points according to scientific capacity of the ship as agreed between OFEG members

Significant advantage: access to wider range of facilities and access to ocean areas that would be beyond reach otherwise. At the same time more efficient use of ship time by reducing cost and time spend on long passages.




