## The ERVO group



- ♦ Informal pan-European long-lasting network (22 years), with no legal status and no financial resources.
- ♦ Created in 1999 as an initiative of the European Science Foundation-Marine Board (ESF-MB) to promote the coordination of small- to medium-sized RVs in Europe.
- → The ERVO Meetings provide an opportunity for RV Managers to exchange information on their national fleets, highlighting trends in the requirements for RVs and new technological developments for RV operations.
- → The success of ERVO can be measured from the fact that the number of participating countries has risen from 7 to 20, proofing to be a useful platform for up to 50 attendees during the yearly meetings.
- ♦ Very useful independent network and its activities are entirely driven by participants who are not 'biased' since ERVO is not being funded by specific interests.





#### The ERVO future



- ♦ ERVO, with its broad membership of operators representing the majority of European countries who have their own research vessel fleet, is the ideal focal point for any organization in Europe looking for ways to communicate directly with the experts on research vessels and related instruments and equipment.
- → ERVO has discussed/implemented some changes over the last years to be more visible, both nationally and on a pan-European level, and to have a "voice" within the European Marine Research (Infrastructure) Community.
- → As indicated in the position paper ERVO should take a more active roll in activities for training for RVrelated personnel & operations, design of RVs, etc.
- ♦ Need to evolve to a more formal ERVO 2.0, possibly in cooperation with or linked to EOOS, Eurofleets+ legacy, OFEG and/or other EU research infrastructure organizations & networks.
