
# NatMIRC-SYKE MRC ICI Project: r/v Mirabilis



## **Background**

- New r/v necessary for NatMIRC use
- Feasibility study by ZA company in Oct 2010 => recommendation to purchase vessel from Finland
- Apparaisal Team appointed by Finnish FORMIN; visit Namibia in December 2010
- Report to FORMIN favourable, decision on Concessional credit support to Namibian Ministry of Fisheries and Marine resources to purchase the vessel from Finland
- Order of new vessel in Feb 2011
- Completed in June 2012, named "Mirabilis", and sailed home...




#### **The ICI Project**


- Finnish FORMIN decided to fund a Institutional cooperation project to assist NatMIRC in utilizing the new ship
- SYKE MRC to act as ICI partner with NatMIRC
- Mutually agreed areas of development: general procedures of r/v management, sampling processes onboard, methodology in different areas of oceanographic sampling, instrumentation, Quality Assurance systems.
- Also assistance/guidance in data management, remote sensing issues, bio-optics, alternative sampling methods and techniques, experimental designs
