

French Oceanographic Fleet


Four Global Class ships all oceans,

All oceans capacity

- Capacity of deployment in all oceans, excepted in the polar areas.



- Diversity of coastal/local ships for a continuum of oceanographic cruises in the coastal zones from the coast to the shelf_break.
- Mean of more than 40 oceanic cruises, 70 coastal cruises and numerous cruises using the local ships






Number of cruises per year









Mean number of days per year: 198 days (Europe) and 285 days (Téthys)







Tethys Mean annual activity per discipline


Europe Mean annual activity per discipline

Biogeographical provinces in the Mediterranean Sea by an analysis of temporal surface chl a time series (D'Ortenzio and D'Alcala)




BioArgo network of buoys deployed in the Med Sea (T, S, O₂, Chl a, CDOM, PAR) since 2015








Mean number of cruises per year: 88 cruises


